What followed was every parent's nightmare – surgeries, weeks in intensive care, and two cardiac arrests.

Today, Rodrigo is recovering – a true miracle. He is back at school, jumping on the trampoline, and exploring the world with his usual curiosity.

Gedvile Kovzonaite, daughter of an employee at UAB DOVISTA in Lithuania, always dreamed of working in the beauty industry. With dedication and hard work, she completed her studies to become a cosmetologist.

The grant from the Employee Foundation allowed Gedvile to purchase essential tools and set up her own workspace, marking the first step toward professional independence.

The Sopron Tigers Sports Association in Hungary promotes youth development and inclusion through sport. Its wheelchair basketball team, a multiple-time national champion, continues to inspire with its achievements.

Thanks to support from the VKR Group Employee Foundation, the club purchased a ball-feeding machine that improves training efficiency. For the team's dedicated athletes, many of whom live with mobility challenges, this innovation makes training more efficient and enjoyable - demonstrating that passion and perseverance know no limits.



Reconnect with Nature in VKR Group Shelters

With the help from 44 voluntary employees from the VKR Group, the first prototypes of architect-designed shelters were constructed in Kronhede, Denmark. These shelters provide more than simple sleeping spaces, the shelters encourage cooking, storytelling, and learning through nature – ideal for visitors, families, and schools seeking new ways to experience the outdoors.
